

# 2017-2018 Rudy Sattler Memorial Scholarships

## Purpose of the Awards

Many students who do not have a strong background in mathematics enroll in a two-year college where all students with a desire to learn are welcomed. OhioMATYC members teach developmental mathematics courses to help students to understand mathematical concepts and to enable them to continue their education. The purpose of this scholarship is to offer financial assistance to developmental mathematics students who are pursuing their dream of higher education.

## Criteria

1. Each qualifying **institution** may submit **one** nomination. To be a qualifying institution, the institution must employ at least one member in good standing of OhioMATYC.
2. The student must be nominated by a current OhioMATYC member who is a current employee of the qualifying institution.
3. The nominated student must have completed or currently be enrolled in a developmental (non-college credit) mathematics course at the qualifying institution.
4. The nominated student must have an overall GPA of at least 2.5.
5. The nominated student must be enrolled full-time at the nominating institution **during fall term 2017 or spring term 2018.**
6. The nomination must include one brief letter of support for the student from a faculty member (other than the nominator) at the nominating institution. **The letter must confirm that the student is enrolled during fall term 2017 or spring term 2018 and meets the minimum GPA requirement.**

## Method of Selection

1. The faculty at each institution should announce to all students in developmental courses that the scholarship exists. Students who meet the criteria should be invited to submit a completed application form to the Mathematics Department, who will determine the nominee.
2. Each institution should then select the one student it wishes to nominate and then send that one student's nomination form (**with letter of support**) back to the past president of OhioMATYC. The nomination form (**with letter of support**) must be received by **March 1, 2018.**
3. Scholarship recipients will be determined by a random draw. The drawing will take place at the Spring Executive Committee meeting or be conducted electronically among the Executive Committee.
4. The scholarship money (\$100 each) will be sent to the recipients (via the nominators) after the winners are determined.
