

OhioMATYC Teaching Excellence Award Criteria and Information

The OhioMATYC Teaching Excellence Award is given at the spring meeting in even-numbered years to outstanding two-year college mathematics instructors. The recipient of this award will be OhioMATYC's nominee for the subsequent AMATYC Teaching Excellence Award providing they meet AMATYC's eligibility requirements. The next round of awards will be presented at the 2018 OhioMATYC Spring Meeting. The winner will receive a recognition plaque and a \$100 check.

Selection Criteria

Eligibility

1. The nominee must currently be a member of OhioMATYC.
2. The nominee's primary assigned duties must be delivering instruction in an associate degree - granting program.
3. The nominee must have at least five years college teaching experience in mathematically related courses.
4. Elected members of the executive committee are not eligible.
5. Previous awardees are not eligible for nominations until three other awardees have been recognized.

Teaching excellence is the main focus of the Teaching Excellence Award.

Criteria for selection are:

Instructional Effectiveness and Support of Students	(25 points)
<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ innovative teaching strategies➤ alternative assessment method➤ curriculum development➤ creating a learning environment for all students➤ accessible to students in and out of the classroom	
Professional Involvement and Professional Development/Renewal Activities	(15 points)
<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ active participation in professional organizations➤ presentations, publications, conferences	
Interaction with Colleagues	(5 points)
<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ sharing and discussing ideas with other colleagues	
Service to Departments/Division/College	(5 points)
<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ active contributor to college community	

Nomination Packet

Nominations are invited from OhioMATYC members
Non-members, such as a supervisor, may nominate an OhioMATYC member.
Members may nominate themselves.

A completed nomination packet consists of:

- ___ Nomination Form (see separate file)
- ___ Cover letter from the nominator (not to exceed 3 pages)
- ___ Resume or vita of the nominee (not to exceed 3 pages, in at least a 12-point font)
- ___ Letters of recommendation from each of: a student, a colleague, and a supervisor (not to exceed 1 page, in at least a 12-point font)
- ___ Summary of the candidate's most recent student evaluations (not to exceed 2 pages, 12-point font)

*Policy dictates that any other additional information will **NOT** be considered.*
