A new process for naming **memorial scholarships** has been established. The individual being honored must be or have been an OhioMATYC member. Any funds donated in someone's name will be added to an OhioMATYC scholarship (currently \$300) at the rate of \$100/year (for a total scholarship of \$400) until the funds run out. The application and award process will not change.
